

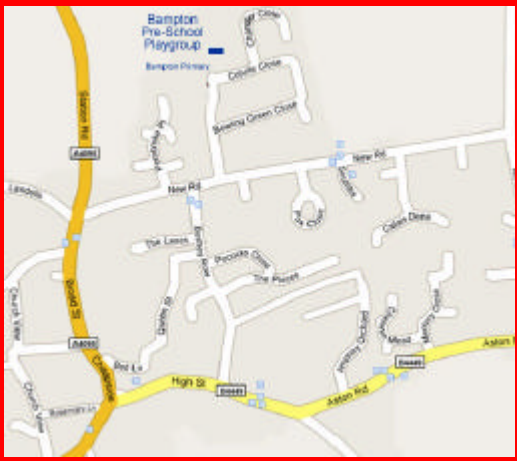
## Aims & Objectives

## Starting Ages & Government Funding

Children are eligible to start Bampton Pre-School when they are two and a half years old and there are 6 intakes per year (every 1/2 term.)

Currently the Government provides funding for pre-school education for all children from the term after their third birthday. At Bampton Pre-School they are funded for 15 hours per week from the term after their third birthday.

If your child is under three or attends for more than 15 hours per week, we will invoice you each term at the hourly rate. If you are receiving income support, some additional Government funding is available for children aged two and a half. Please ask for more details.

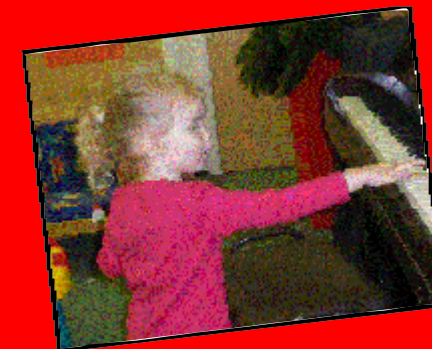
## Ofsted/ Accreditations
